Join us at King's Maths school in a journey of fun-filled physics. Here's what you'll get up to:

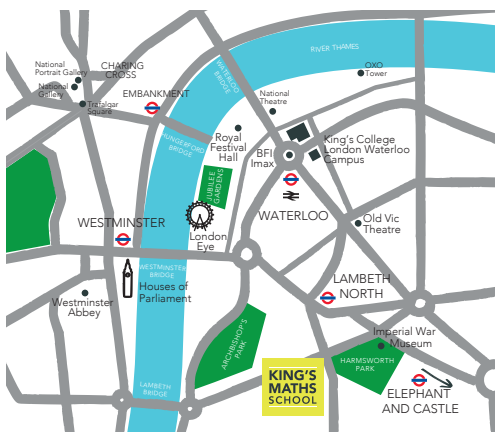
- Solidify your understanding with experienced, skilled and knowledgeable physics teachers.

As our goal is to widen participation in Physics, we will prioritise applications from students who meet any of these criteria:

- attend a non-selective state school
- do not have parent(s) or carer(s) who have studied at university
- have been eligible for Free School Meals in any of the past 6 years
- live or have lived in local authority care, are a young carer, or have a disability
- are traditionally underrepresented in physics in Higher Education
