Bushcraft



Careers & speaker-events

In addition to cultural trips, we had excellent academic and business related events dotted throughout this term. Highlights included our annual Insight Day at MAN Group, where our students learned about careers in investment and asset management and how mathematics ties into everything. We also attended a fascinating lecture on aerodynamics and Navier-Stokes hosted by G-Research.



Competitions & Olympiads

KCLMS has gone from strength to strength in maths competitions this term. In October, 143 students sat the Senior Maths Challenge; of these, exactly 100 received a Gold Certificate. 54 students attempted the new British Physics Olympiad Round 0, including many brave Year 12s, of which 34 students qualified to Round 1. In Computer Science, 83 students sat the Bebras challenge, of which 17 students scored a Gold putting them in the top 10% of the country.
